- ABV: 13.5%
- pH: 3.7
- TA: 0.58 g/100mL
- Blend: 45% Grenache Blanc; 45% Picpoul; 10% Vermentino
- Vineyard sources: Rancho Cuejito Vineyard (Grenache Blanc + Picpoul); Pauma Vineyard (Vermentino)
- Organically farmed (non-certified)
- Pick date: September 15, 2020
- Brix at harvest: 23-23.5°
- Hand-picked, winery hand-sorted
- Destemmed & co-fermented on skins for 30 days before pressing
- Native primary & malolactic fermentation
- Aged in neutral barrels for 8 months
- 15ppm SO₂ before bottling (only addition of any kind)
- Bottled May 24, 2021
- The Name: The label image is taken from a very old wooden telephone pole in Emily & Jody's neighborhood. Packed with nails and screws from a bygone age, when posting printed signs was the way for everyday people to broadcast messages of all sorts, the pole has been a poignant piece of iconography for us for many years - an island of souls.
